

# OLNEY TOWN COUNCIL

On Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September, Aldi hosted a public consultation event from 2.00pm – 7.00pm at The Olney Centre. ALDI along with MPC and Angle Property were all onsite during the day to answer any questions.

Here is a brief summary Olney Town Council have received from the days event:

- In total 74 local residents attended the event, including four of the Town Councillors.
- 41 feedback cards were returned on the day, with a further feedback response returned online.
- Of the 41 feedback cards received on the day, 30 were supportive of the proposals.
- Just five explicitly said they were against the proposals.
- 27 respondents believed there was not enough variety for food shopping in Olney.
- The main concern that attendees had was the impact the store would have on the road network and additional traffic in the town.
- Other points raised included; potential for motorbike parking, the output power of the electric vehicle charging and how kerbs at the blue badge parking spaces may impact users of those spaces.
