This mask will best help you to prevent spread of COVID virus to other people even if you are asymptomatic and vice versa. Remember this virus is very infective on any public surfaces.

About Rotary Club of Stratford

Rotary has been serving our community for 98 years. Each year, the Rotary Club of Stratford raises \$80,000 through our many fundraisers such as our Home and Leisure Show, Catch the Ace, Dragonboat Festival just to name a few.

Our mask

This mask is made in Stratford by volunteer sewers with the assistance of a local manufacturer SewWear in Brunner. The mask is designed by Wendy Wilkinson and is reusable, durable and environmentally friendly. The outer layer is a polyester cotton blend and the inner a soft cotton knit.

Care and use instructions for your mask

Wash the mask in warm water and detergent after 8 to 12 hours of use.

Wash your hands for 20 sec before putting on and taking off your mask.

Do not touch your face or adjust mask unless you wash your hands first.

Store the mask in a paper bag with inner part folded in.

Handle the mask by the straps.
