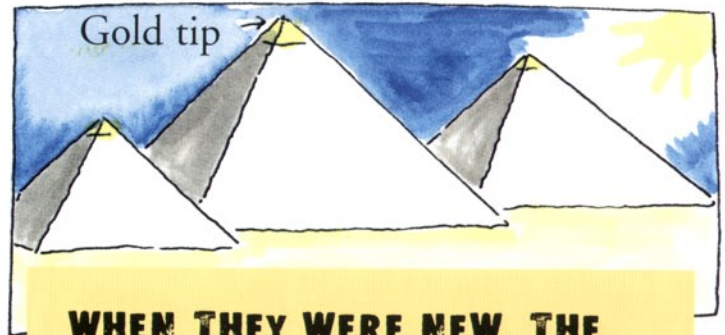


HOW TO MAKE A PYRAMID

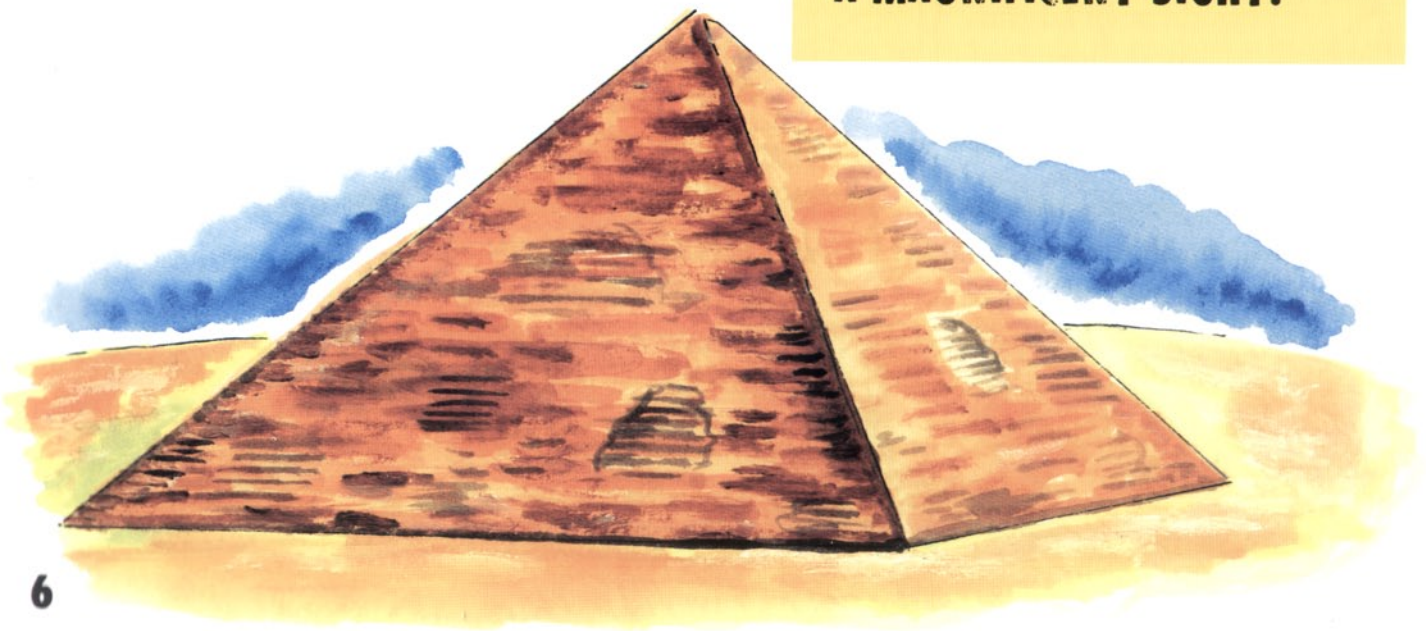
Have a go at making your own Great Pyramid. Make a small one first to see how it works, then make a bigger one. It could even be big enough to get inside and frighten people using a ghostly voice! Give your Great Pyramid an aged look by tearing off the paper in places to show the corrugations underneath. Use your paints to make it look old or new.

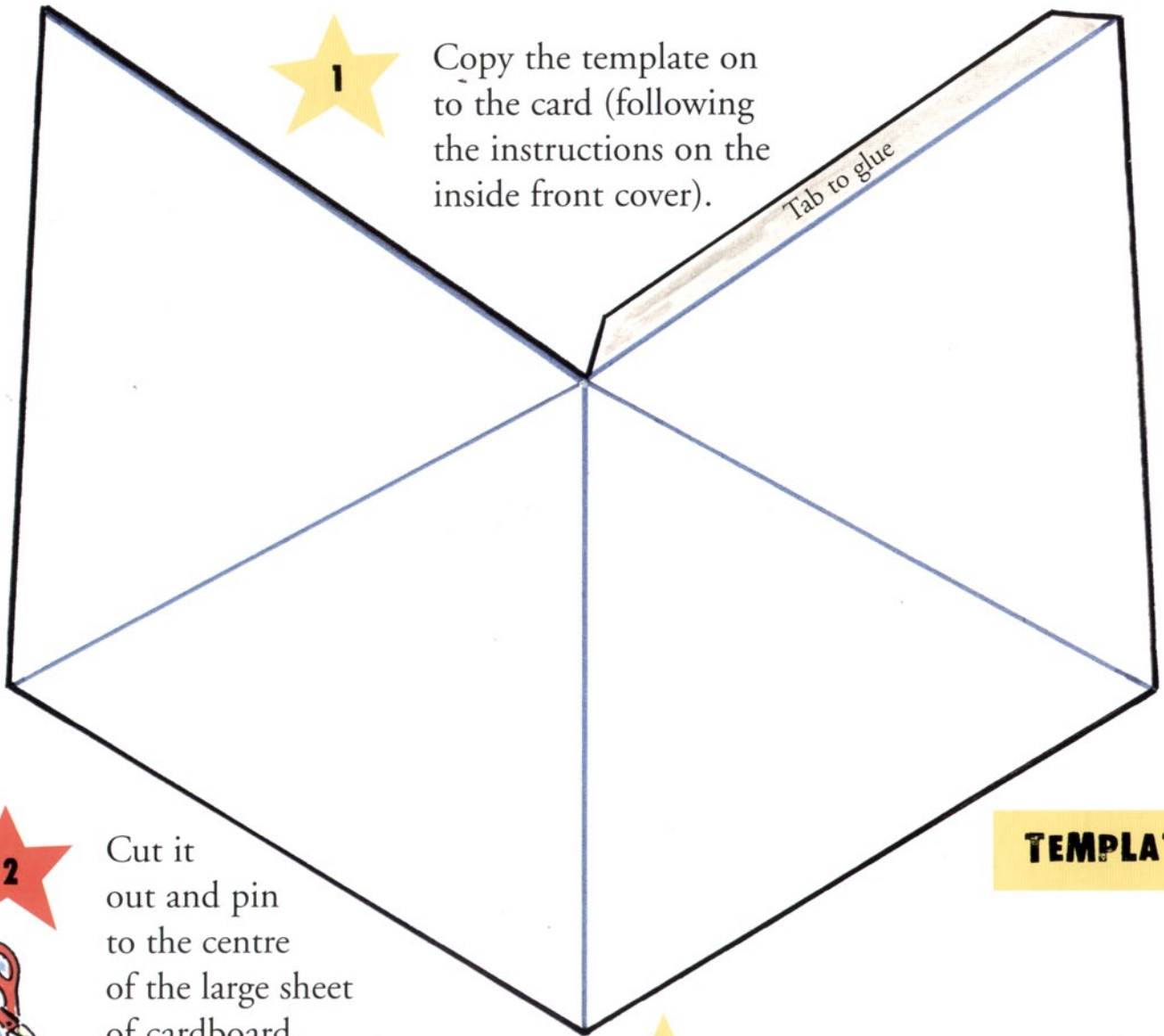
YOU'LL NEED:

Scissors, craft knife, glue, ruler, pencil, tracing paper, masking tape, ballpoint pen, thin card, large piece of corrugated cardboard and drawing-pin.



WHEN THEY WERE NEW, THE PYRAMIDS WERE COVERED IN BRILLIANT WHITE LIMESTONE WHICH WOULD HAVE GLINTED IN THE SUNLIGHT. WHAT A MAGNIFICENT SIGHT!





Copy the template on to the card (following the instructions on the inside front cover).

TEMPLATE



Cut it out and pin to the centre of the large sheet of cardboard.



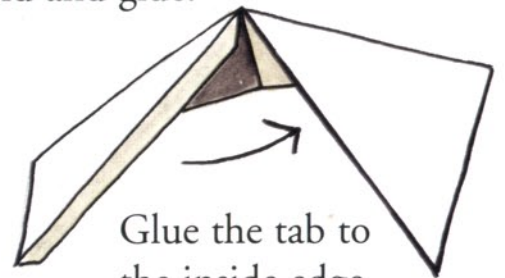
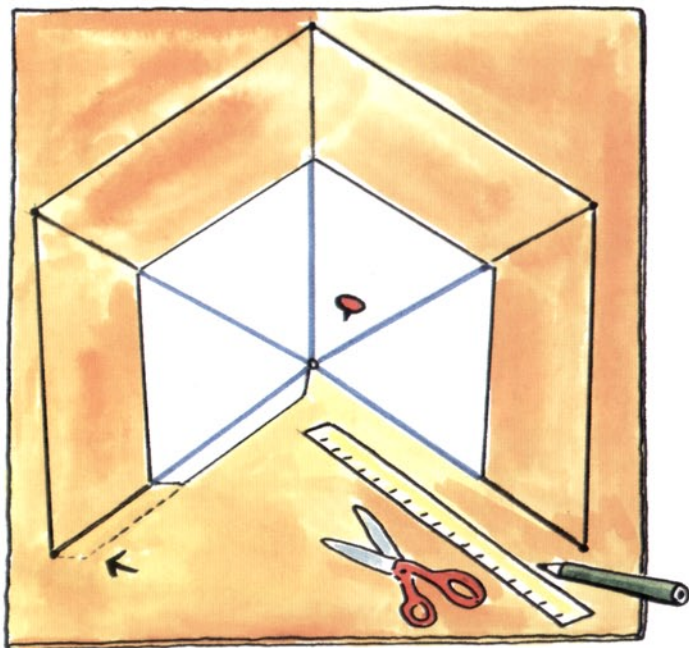
Use your ruler to extend the five blue lines by equal lengths. Draw four lines to join the ends.



Remove the template and draw the lines to the centre.



Extend the tab, cut out, score, fold and glue.



Glue the tab to the inside edge.
