

OIL PAINTING FOR BEGINNERS

This materials list consists of mandatory items, as well as <u>optional</u> items. Any additional materials that you already have in your artist's toolkit are always welcome. Suggested brand names are *'italicized'*. While all materials can be found at *Opus Art Supplies*, similar products and brands from other stores are welcome.

WHAT WE PROVIDE

Easels, glass palettes, side tables, chairs & stools, containers for liquids, masking tape, and saran wrap.

PENCIL & ERASER

- Graphite pencil (HB or 2B), or any dark pencil crayon
- 'Staedtler' Mars Plastic Eraser

PAINT

- Titanium White
- Yellow Ochre
- Cadmium Yellow Lemon (or Cad Yellow Pale or Bismuth Yellow)
- · Cadmium Red Medium
- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umber
- Ivory Black

<u>NOTE</u>: It is recommended to use 'artist grade' vs. 'student grade' paint. Affordable brands include *Holbein*, *Gamblin*, *Winsor & Newton (not Winton)*, *Opus Essentials*, or *Kama Oil paint (Rath Art Supplies)*, as well as *Rembrandt (DeSerres)*. More expensive brands are welcome.

MEDIUM

- Gamblin's 'Gamsol' Odourless Mineral Spirits (please don't bring other brands)
- NOTE: Please do not bring turpentine/scented solvents.

BRUSHES

- Bring a few long-handled brushes between sizes 2 and 8
- Recommended: Synthetic Filberts (sizes 4, 6 and 8)
- 1 Filbert, Bright or Flat (any size between 10 and 12)
- A few synthetic Round (size 6 8)
- · In addition to this list, please bring sizes and shapes you're comfortable with

SURFACE

- Bring two gessoed hardboard panels: any size between 8" x 10" to 11" x 14"
- · Note: you can bring canvas, however hardboard panel is preferred
- SURFACE PREPARATION: All surfaces require a total of 3 layers of gesso.
 Surfaces with gesso already included, please add 2 more layers, allowing to dry between layers.

PALETTE

A glass palette is provided, although you are welcome to bring your own.

PALETTE KNIFE

Any size, although we recommend the 'Liqutex' Small Painting Knife #8.

PAPER TOWELS & RAGS

- Bring one roll of 'Scott's Shop Towels' (blue). Found at any commercial painting and lumber stores.

SKETCHBOOK

Any size (a small one is fine): used for taking notes and doing various

homework exercises

GLOVES (optional)

- While Painting: Latex or 'Guerilla Grip' gloves (breathable + waterproof)
- Brush Cleaning: Waterproof rubber gloves are strongly recommended.

CLOTHING

• Painting can be messy, please bring suitable clothing.
