

OIL PAINTING FOR BEGINNERS

While all materials can be found at Opus Art Supplies, similar products and brands from other stores are welcome. Suggested brand names are 'italicized'. Additional materials are also welcome.

WHAT WE PROVIDE

• Easels, glass palettes, side tables, chairs & stools, containers for liquids, masking tape, and saran wrap

SURFACE

- <u>3 Surfaces:</u> any size between 8" x 10" to 11" x 14"
- Gessoed hardboard panel is preferred (aka 'Artboard' or 'Ampersand'). Canvas board or stretched canvas are also welcome.
- Please bring just one surface to first class.
- All surfaces require a total of 3 layers of acrylic white gesso. With pre-gessoed surfaces, please add 2 more layers, allowing to dry between layers.

PAINT

We suggest using artist-grade vs. student-grade paint.

 Titanium White / Yellow Ochre / Cadmium Red Medium / Burnt Sienna / Cadmium Yellow Lemon (or Cadmium Yellow Light / Bismuth Yellow) / Raw Umber / Ultramarine Blue / Ivory Black

BRUSHES

Please bring a range of shapes & sizes, and whatever brushes you enjoy working with. We recommend the following long-handled brushes:

- 2 Synthetic Filberts: any sizes between 4, 6 and 8
- 1 Bristle Filbert, Bright or Flat: any size between 10 and 12
- 2-3 Synthetic Rounds: any sizes between 6 and 8

MEDIUM

For Oils: Linseed Oil + OMS (Odourless Mineral Spirits)

- Use 'Gamblin Gamsol' only! Please do not bring other brands or turpentine.
- Bring an extra glass jar + lid to store excess dirty OMS after class.

For Acrylics:

- Bring a small spray water bottle to keep your paint wet.
- Optional: Acrylic Retarder to extend drying time
- Optional: Use 'Golden Open Acrylics' which stay wet for 24 hours.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- Acrylic White Gesso: Small bottle for surface preparation
- Palette Knife: 'Liquitex' Small Painting Knife #8
- <u>Paper Towel</u>: 'Scott's Shop Towels' (blue) Click <u>Here</u>
- <u>Pencil</u>: Graphite pencil (HB or 2B), or any dark pencil crayon
- Eraser: 'Staedtler' Mars Plastic Eraser
- Painting can be messy, please bring suitable clothing.

OPTIONAL

- Sketchbook: 8.5" x 11" (or smaller) for taking notes.
- <u>Paint 'Razor' Scraper</u>: (to clean & organize your glass palette).
- Gloves While Painting: Latex or 'Gorilla Grip' gloves (breathable + waterproof)
- Gloves for Brush Cleaning: Waterproof rubber gloves are recommended.
- Mahl stick
