*Domestic cut off dates*

Standard Post – Dec 14

First Class & Priority – Dec 19

Express Dec 20

*International cut off dates*

Central & South America and Africa Dec 1 - 1<sup>st</sup> class & Priority \* Dec 8 Express

Asia, Australia, Canada, Mexico, Europe & Middle East Dec 8 - 1<sup>st</sup> class & Priority \* Dec 8 Express

APO/FPO/DPO Military Addresses (depending on zip code)

Standard Nov 6 \* 1<sup>st</sup> class & Priority Dec 2 – 9 \* Express Dec 16



*Domestic cut off dates*

Ground - Dec 14 (to the East Coast)

2<sup>nd</sup> Day Air - Dec 20

Next Day Air - Fri, Dec 21 (*to get there Christmas Eve – Mon, Dec 24<sup>th</sup>!*)



Ground – Dec 14 (to the East Coast)

2 Day – Dec 20

Overnight Service – Dec 21
