In the impoverished Southside neighborhood of Belize City, Friends United Meeting has run a school for at-risk teens for over twenty years, but there's never been a Friends church...



The staff of the school have seen that both their students and the wider community hunger for the living word of Christ, the one who can facilitate the neighborhood's transformation from a place of hopelessness and violence to a place of hope and peace. God has called Oscar Mmbali as pastoral minister for Belize in response to that hunger.

Many Southside families struggle with violence, drugs, poverty, and lack of education, in addition to a lack of the knowledge of the living Christ. As Oscar Mmbali becomes deeply involved in the life of this community, he will learn from them and invite them into a relationship with Christ.

Oscar is an experienced church planter with international ministry experience in Africa and Asia. He has academic credentials in ministry, theology, and international development. He is uniquely equipped to gather people into a Christ-loving fellowship in Belize City.
