

MEDICATION AUTHORIZATION SERVICE

If your doctor has written a prescription, he or she deems that prescription appropriate for your treatment. This prescription is the only authorization required for you to obtain this drug from your pharmacy.

Many insurance companies are impeding this process by insisting that a separate “authorization” is required for certain drugs. What used to be accomplished by a single trip to the pharmacy now often requires phone calls to the insurance company and burdensome paperwork.

We know how stressful it can be when you cannot get the medication your doctor has prescribed. We understand the frustration of the numerous phone calls to your pharmacy, insurance company and physician’s office.

If your insurance company requires authorization for a prescription written by one of our doctors, we are here to help.

We now offer a medication authorization service for a fee of **\$25.00**. We require this fee be paid before we start the authorization process. With this service, our office will deal directly with your insurance company and your pharmacy and attempt to obtain “authorization” from your insurance company.

If we receive an authorization request from your pharmacy or insurance company, we will contact you to confirm that you would like to use our service. Once we have confirmed this and payment has been made, we will immediately start the process. This process commonly takes up to 2 weeks. If you would like the process expedited, additional fees may apply.

Our primary relationship is with our patients, not the insurance company. We will do everything we can to get authorization for the medication your doctor has prescribed for your condition.

Please understand that although the physicians of Medical Specialists, Inc. (and not the insurance companies) are licensed prescribers in the state of Oklahoma, the insurance companies ultimately make the decision of coverage.
