Q What do I do if I see someone being bullied?

Always support him or her

Act on their behalf

If you are by yourself, ask for the help of friends

Q How do I support someone?

Assure the victim that you will help them

Ask for your friends to support the victim

Ask for the help of an adult

Make sure the bully knows that bullying is unacceptable at The Downs

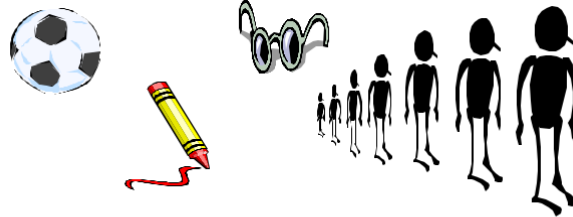

- *They might send un - pleasant photographs



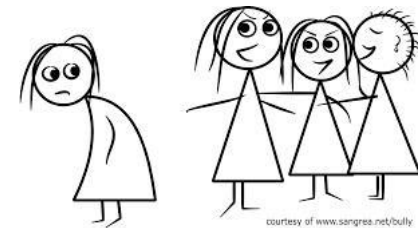
- *They might send nasty text messages
