### 1. Introduction

<sup>1</sup> **The present protection concept is based on the updated Covid-19- Measures and Orders of the Federal Council dated April 14, 2021, and applies from April 19, 2021.**

Purpose

<sup>2</sup> The protection concept is limited to individual lessons and lessons in groups.

Area of application

<sup>3</sup> Responsible for the implementation of the measures in sections 3 to 5 is school management, for the execution in sections 4 and 5 the Teacher. Is there, in the opinion of a teacher, the possibility of an adjustment for a certain measure, the teacher should contact the school principal. This is responsible for deciding on the further procedure.

### 2. Persons

<sup>4</sup> All face-to-face classroom offerings may be unrestricted across all grade levels and with adults.

Commitment

- Group and ensemble activities (lessons, rehearsals, performances without an audience) may take place for children and young people up to and including the year 2001 without a fixed upper limit of persons, including activities with singing, singing groups and choirs. The activities are to be done with a protection concept and in compliance with the basic rules regarding distance, masks and airing.
- Group and ensemble activities including singing (lessons and rehearsals) for adults over 20 years of age (born 2000 or older) may take place indoors up to a maximum of 15 persons with supplementary protective measures (mask and distance, ventilation); outdoors, a maximum of 15 participants is also possible (with mask or distance). This is always possible with the use of appropriate protection concepts.
- If it is not possible to wear a mask during activities involving singing, wind instruments, or significant physical exertion, an area of at least 25m<sup>2</sup> must be provided for each person or effective barriers must be installed between each person. (Plexiglas protective wall).
- There is a nationwide mask obligation in the publicly accessible rooms and in the classrooms for all from the age of 12 years, which is to be implemented according to the federal regulation. The obligation to wear masks does not apply to teaching activities that are made difficult or impossible (wind instruments), provided that an additional distance is maintained in large rooms with good ventilation. (Plexiglas protective wall).

<sup>5</sup> Teachers who are particularly at risk should continue to be able to avoid contact with other people and therefore remain for the time being home. This is based on the assumption that the teacher is not sick, until further notice, it will provide musical distance learning (online). Distance learning (Online)

<sup>6</sup> Students who do not wish to take part in face-to-face training until further notice continue to receive distance learning online. An application must be submitted to the school management. Alternative offer

### 3. Building

<sup>7</sup> At the entrances and in the toilets there are posters of Federal Office of Public Health FOPH (<https://bag-coronavirus.ch/downloads/>) to be installed. Announcements

<sup>8</sup> Toilet facilities, door and window handles, handrails and the operating surfaces of photocopiers and other freely accessible Equipment must be cleaned or disinfected regularly. Cleaning

### 4. Rooms

<sup>9</sup> It must be possible to ventilate the teaching rooms after each teaching sequence by opening the windows. Ventilation

<sup>10</sup> Sufficient large classrooms must be chosen. Rooms

### 5. Lessons

<sup>11</sup> The hygiene measures issued by the Federal Office of Public Health FOPH must be respected. Teachers and students wash their hands thoroughly before and after lessons. The minimum distance of 1.5 meters from the students must be maintained if possible. 3 meters for wind instruments. Hygiene behaviour

Since 26 August 2020, adults and children older than 12 years of age are generally required to wear masks.

<sup>12</sup> Teachers and students should play on their personal instruments during lessons if possible. Instruments  
The following instruments are excluded: piano, keyboard, percussion, drum set, amplifier and boxes for electric instruments.  
Any school instruments provided should be treated with a suitable disinfectant or wipes before and after each lesson sequence.
