4. Competition program

Qualifications and finales in all disciplines

Qualifications:

- Mixed 8 - 14 years Boys and girls
- Age group 15 years and older men
- Age group 15 years and older women
- Elite Youth boys
- Elite Youth girls
- Elite Junior boys
- Elite Junior girls
- Elite Senior men
- Elite Senior women

Finals: top 5 or 8 of the qualifications, depending upon the number of participants in each category.

1 to 8 participants	Max. 5 finalists
Over 9 participants	Max. 8 finalists

Determination of final ranking:

According to Code of Points FIG

5. Technical Rules

The following FIG rules will be used :

- Code Of Points (with the exception of the maximum difficulty for the open class)

6. Judges

Each participating club or federation with 1-4 competitors has to sign in at least 1 judge. With 5-8 competitors 2 judges, with 9-12 competitors 3 judges, etc. If not, a penalty of € 60,- will be calculated for each missing judge. With these penalties the LOC will be able to replace judges. All judges must have a valid national judge brevet (judges are able to judge at the highest national level).

7. Draw for starting order

The draw will take place on May 15th 2020 under the supervision of the organization comity and the trampoline gymnastics competition manager. Each athlete will receive their own number that needs to be filled in on the tariff sheet, that need to be send back by e-mail.

8. Accreditation competition

Accreditation:

- Flik-Flak hall, ground floor (info point)
- Wednesday May 20th from 09.00 – 21.00
- Thursday May 21th from 07.15 – 08.30

The accreditation system identifies the individual participation of gymnasts and shows who can enter which area. All participants, coaches and judges are required to have their accreditation with them at all times.

During the accreditation, the coaches check all the names for the entire delegation and hand over the competition cards for their gymnasts. They are also in possession of all the passports of the participants so that the date of birth and nationality can be checked. Coaches will receive the final competition schedule.

The accreditation is personal, cannot be lent to someone else. It is mandatory to have the accreditation to get access to the training and competition facilities, meals and staying overnight.
