1. Conversations must happen one-on-one. You are not allowed to form small groups to ask several people a question at one time.

2. You may not use a person's name more than once.

3. You are only permitted to ask a person three questions before they have to move onto the next person.

- 4. If the person you are talking to answers "yes" to a scavenger hunt item, you must write that person's name in the box next to the item and answer any questions associated with that item. For example, if a student says they visited an amusement park, then the person asking the questions must find out which park their classmate went to and which ride was their favorite.
- 5. The student asking the questions must write their partner's name and details on their paper. They should not hand their paper to the person they are talking to and ask them to write their name and information.
