

Breed Survey Class Improvement

The owner of an animal selected in Breed Survey Class 2 may present the animal between the dates of January 1 and December 31 of the first year of this Breed Survey for a Breed Survey Class Improvement. A Breed Survey class improvement, if granted, does not extend the time span of the original Breed Survey.

Breed Survey Extension for one year

Pregnant or lactating females can be reselected for one additional year during the year presentation for Reselection for life is necessary without having to appear at the survey. This applies only to females that are at least 42 days pregnant at the time of the Breed Survey or lactating females when the time between the date of whelping and the Breed Survey does not exceed 42 days. Contact the USA Office for the documentation required to be presented at the Breed Survey.

Reselection for life

Reselection for life is possible for the animal named herein, between the dates of January 1 and December 31 of the second year of this breed survey, unless a Breed Survey Extension for one year has been granted.
