AN ANNUAL 2½ DAY SUMMER RETREAT FACILITATED BY ADMISSION OFFICERS FROM AROUND THE COUNTRY, COLLEGE ADVISORS, AND SCHOOL COUNSELORS WHO DONATE THEIR TIME AND TRAVEL TO COME TO CAMP COLLEGE.

Students meet with a faculty of college admission officers and high school and college counselors who lead them in sessions including **writing a compelling essay, college fair etiquette, mock application review, and financial aid workshops.**

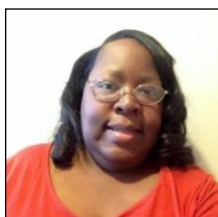
