The *Project Manager* will work closely with the Executive Director and team to:

  - Support partner organizations through shadowing template development, on-site shadowing, report generation, coaching, training, and improvement initiatives as needed
- Own, improve, and support maintenance on goShadow's custom app, platform, and reporting software.
  - o QA and provide detailed analysis of desired app/platform improvement and maintenance
- Support development of training and course offerings:
  - Creation of content such as: videos, tools, and slide decks to facilitate courses
  - o Provide didactic and coaching to participants with the Executive Director
- Manage and support clients independently with other team members to provide value, enhance processes, and deliver an excellent client experience
  - Design, implement, and measure improvement projects with healthcare providers and administrators from multi-hospital systems in Pittsburgh, PA and across the world
- Lead and mentor up to 5 undergraduate and graduate interns in the program at a time.
- Strategize, implement, and measure success of marketing initiatives such as: email campaigns, social media, and content creation
- Self-starter approach; seek out and participate in local networking opportunities to generate interest in goShadow's work and grow clientele.

### **Required & Desired Skills**

The ideal candidate will have 3-5 years of healthcare experience or 5+ years of healthcare coursework. They will be a self starter and enjoy working in an agile, start-up-like environment. They will have excellent verbal and written communication skills, marketing and sales interest, customer-focus, strong project management and organizational skills, and experience using Google and Microsoft suite products, specifically Excel spreadsheet functionality. Website development or python experience is preferred. A successful candidate will thrive in a fast-paced, team environment that requires creativity and wearing of many hats on a daily basis.
