An art trip to Europe with Educating Adventures encourages students to explore ideas, find new inspiration and understand the historical and theoretical context behind different art movements.




TRIP SUMMARY & ITINERARY

DAYS 1 - 3

Arrive in the ancient capital of the Roman Empire and one of the world's oldest continuously occupied sites, Rome. enjoy a three hour guided walk of Ancient Rome, including entrance and a guided tour of the mighty Colosseum.

EXPLORE TWO STATES IN ONE CITY IN ROME AND THE VATICAN CITY.

Take a tour of the smallest country in the world, The Vatican City, including a guided tour of St Peter's Basilica and the Sistine Chapel, where you will see awe-inspiring works from Michelangelo. In the afternoon, explore the city with a Renaissance and Baroque walking tour of Rome.





DAYS 4 - 6

Travel like a Parisian on the Metro, and make your way to one of the world's largest art museums: The Louvre, where you will enjoy a guided tour. Visit the Centre Pompidou, the largest modern art gallery in Europe.

EXPLORE THE WORLD'S MOST FAMOUS GALLERIES AND EXHIBITIONS

Visit the stunning Musée D'Orsay, which displays the largest collection of impressionist and post impressionist masterpieces in the world and is housed in the former station Gare D'Orsay.

Climb to the second floor of the world's most viewed monument, the Eiffel Tower.



DAYS 7 - 10

Enjoy a guided tour of Vincent Van Gogh's last residence, where he painted many of his masterpieces. Travel on to Giverny to visit Claude Monet's garden, where he produced the famous water lily series.

EXPLORE THE WONDERFUL ARCHITECTURE OF BARCELONA AND VISIT LA SAGRADA FAMILIA.

Take an excursion to the lovely medieval town of Girona and enjoy a guided walking tour here. Head onto Figueres, Dali's home town, and explore his theatrical museum housing the largest collection of the works of Dali in the world. After a great trip away, it's time to fly back to your home country.
