Backflow Tester:

Carroll County Water Authority (CCWA) requires that individuals wishing to test backflow prevention assemblies in the areas served by CCWA submit a completed Tester Information Form #20-0219 along with all applicable documentation.

In order to increase test report legibility, CCWA has begun using our own updated Test and Maintenance Report (#20-0101) which is available as a form-fill document in PDF or Microsoft Word format. All forms will soon be available by download from our website at <https://www.ccwageorgia.com/backflow-prevention>. You may print or email the completed form-fill test report to submit to CCWA, or you may print the blank test report and submit it with the data included in typed form. Unreadable test reports will not be accepted. The methods of Test Report submission are listed at the bottom of the report form.

Carroll County Water Authority serves unincorporated portions of Carroll County and is a separate entity from all cities in the county. Anyone wishing to test backflow prevention assemblies in the cities of Carrollton, Villa Rica, Temple, or Whitesburg, Ropville, Mt. Zion, or Bowdon must contact each city in order to meet their specific requirements.
