I've had the honor of playing, singing, recording and traveling the world with many of Philly's great Artists from Teddy Pendergrass and Patti Labelle to Blue Magic and Sister Sledge; I've also shared the stage with world renowned Artists from Stevie Wonder to Kirk Whalum.
