

ANNUAL REPORT 2010 – 2011

HIGHLIGHTS

The Executive Committee of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation, based in Winnipeg, held six (6) meetings during the 2010 - 2011 fiscal year, ending April 30. Nine provincial / regional trustees chair awards committees and distribute information about the Foundation to local meetings and conferences. Elizabeth Feniak, CM, PhD is the Honorary Chair and Trustee Emeritus. The Canadian Home Economics Foundation operates with volunteers and no paid staff. Administration costs for the year are less than \$600.00 or one percentage.

The 30th Board of Trustees meeting and the Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition were held at the Holiday Inn South in Winnipeg, Manitoba in conjunction with the MAHE/MHETA Conference in October 2010.

From May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011 funding of \$36,752 was approved for twenty-three grants and awards in the areas of research, education, public service and post-secondary education and training. Donations and bequests totaled \$32,395.

Two winners of the 2010-2011 Dr. Elizabeth Feniak Award for Excellence in Technical Writing have had their papers published in the Journal of Home Economics Institute of Australia Vol. 18 No. 1, 2011: "Should Marketing of Unhealthy Foods and Beverages to Children be Regulated?" 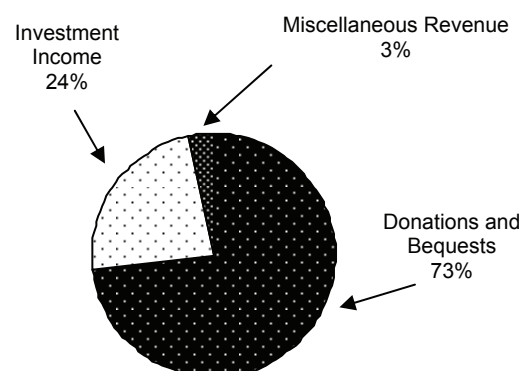

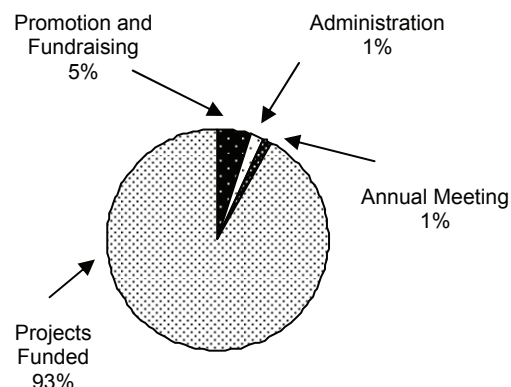
