



## ANNUAL REPORT 2012 – 2013

### HIGHLIGHTS

The Executive Committee of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation, based in Winnipeg, held six (6) meetings during the 2012 - 2013 fiscal year, ending April 30. Nine provincial / regional trustees distribute information about the Foundation to local meetings and conferences, and some chair awards committees. The Canadian Home Economics Foundation operates with volunteers and no paid staff.

The 32nd Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition was held on Friday, September 28, 2012 in Swift Current SK in conjunction with the Association of Saskatchewan Home Economists/ Saskatchewan Home Economics Teachers Association Conference. The Board of Trustees meeting was held Thursday, September 27, 2013 in Swift Current SK.

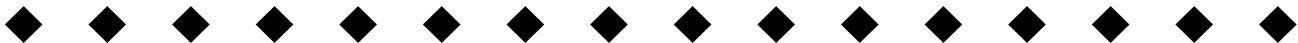
From May 1, 2012 to April 30, 2013 funding of \$30,409 was approved for twenty-five grants and awards across Canada and internationally in the areas of research, education, public service and post-secondary education and training. Donations and bequests totaled \$30,505.

A new guideline, "Funding Terms of Reference for all Projects supported by the Canadian Home Economics Foundation" was approved and posted on the website.

All of the trustees have agreed to continue to serve on the Foundation's Board with approximately one-third of the terms ending in each of 2014, 2015 and 2016.

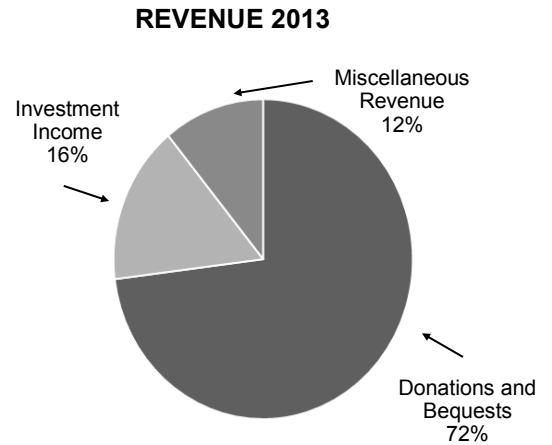

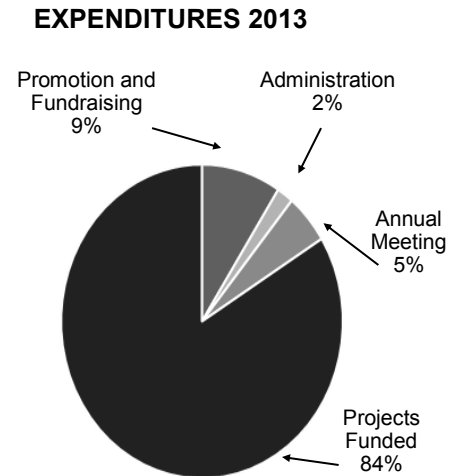
