

ANNUAL REPORT 2013 – 2014

HIGHLIGHTS

The Executive Committee of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation, based in Winnipeg, held seven (7) meetings during the 2013 - 2014 fiscal year, ending April 30. Nine provincial/ regional trustees chair awards committees and distribute information about the Foundation to local meetings and conferences. The Canadian Home Economics Foundation operates with volunteers and no paid staff.

The 33rd Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition was held on Friday, October 25, 2013 in Coquitlam, BC in conjunction with the Teachers of Home Economics Specialist Association (THESA) Conference. The Board of Trustees Meeting was held Thursday, October 24, 2013 at the POCO Inn and Suites in Coquitlam, BC.

From May 1, 2013 to April 30, 2014 funding of \$32,802 was approved for 25 grants and awards across Canada and internationally in the areas of education, public service and post-secondary education and training. Donations and bequests totaled \$30,188. A PayPal button was added to the website.

The Executive began the process of Continuance under the Canada Not-for-Profit Corporations Act (NFP Act) for Canadian Home Economics Foundation/La Fondation canadienne pour l'Économie familiale in 2013.

Mari Parks has resigned from the Board, serving as a trustee for four years. Donna Bulow and Gail Watson have extended their term for three years and Elizabeth Jennaway Eaman and Margaret Prouse have extended their terms for one year. Marilyn Weber, St. Catharines, ON is joining the Board for a three year term.

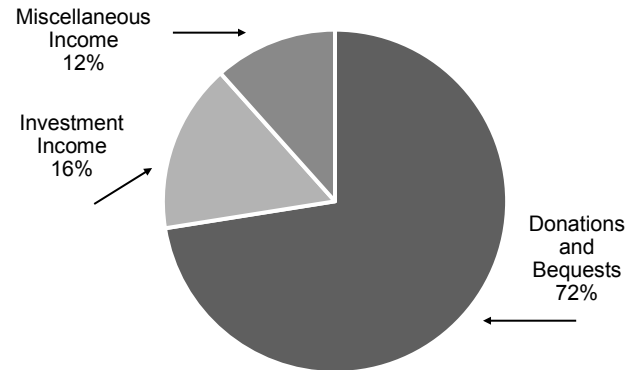

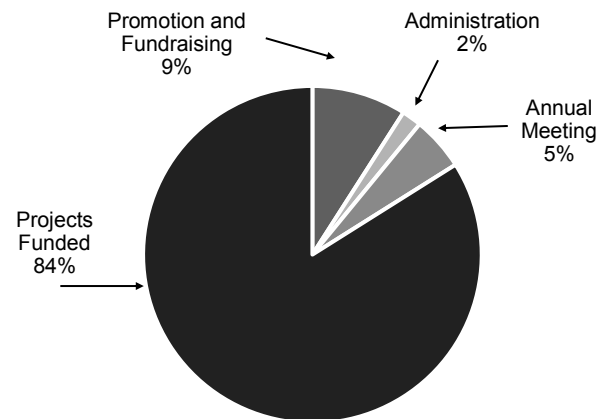
