

## ANNUAL REPORT 2018 – 2019

### HIGHLIGHTS

The Executive Committee of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation, based in Winnipeg, Manitoba, held six (6) regular meetings during the 2018-2019 fiscal year ending April 30. Nine provincial/regional trustees chair awards committees and distribute information about the Foundation to local meetings and conferences. The Canadian Home Economics Foundation operates with volunteers and no paid staff.

The 38th Board of Trustees meeting was held on October 15, 2018 at Eleanor Cassels' residence in Winnipeg MB. The 38th Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation was held October 27, 2018 in conjunction with the Manitoba Association of Home Economists seminar in Winnipeg MB.

From May 1, 2018 to April 30, 2019 funding of \$58,502 was approved for 35 grants and awards in nine provinces in the areas of research, education, public service and post-secondary education and training. Donations and bequests totaled \$48,625 that included a substantial donation from Rosemary Oddie in memory of her mother, Emmie Oddie. This donation is designated for the Emmie Oddie website, [www.homefamily.net](http://www.homefamily.net) or other worthy projects. The Foundation also received \$26,775.42, the remaining funds from Canadian Home Economics Association (CHEA Bylaw 2003).

On the recommendation of the Home Economics Teacher Education – University of Saskatchewan (USHETE) Award committee, the name and terms were changed to Saskatchewan Home Economics Education Award.

The number of Graduate Student Awards was increased from five

awards of \$1000 each to eight awards of \$1,000 based on input from a trustee.

The Canadian Home Economics Foundation approved the re-design of the web site by Modern Earth. The launch of the "web-site re-design" will coincide with the 40th anniversary of the Foundation 2019-2020.

Jean Fraser-McHarg and Trinkie Coffin have retired from reviewing the projects for the Atlantic Canada Community Project Award after serving for 15 years. Sue McGregor, NS trustee, Kathy Bourbonnière and Elaine Seniuk from Nova Scotia will serve as the committee to administer the project as of May 1, 2019. Sue McGregor is the contact person.

Six terms of office on the Board of Trustees end following the Board of Trustees meeting on October 29, 2019. Retiring from the Board are: Executive trustees, Ann Halbesma, communications and development and Donna Ryland, project coordinator after serving on the Board for three years; and Provincial trustee Mary Leah de Zwart after serving on the Board for nine years. Their input is very much appreciated. Trustees willing to extend their term of office are: Executive trustee Marlene McDonald, communications and development to 2021 and Provincial/regional trustees Jane Forest, ON, Ruth E McDonald, ON and Claudia Thierry, QC for a three-year extension to 2022.

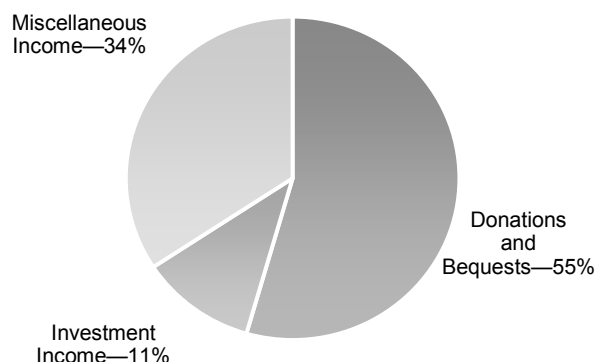

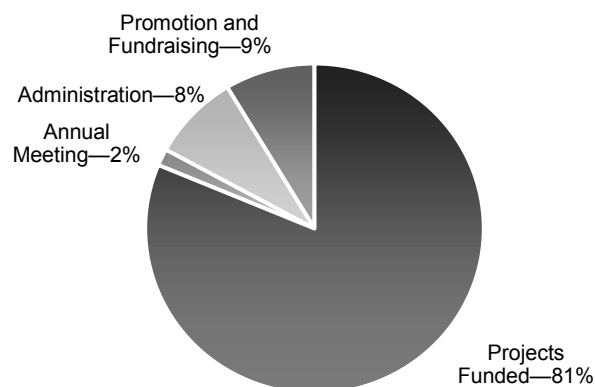
