## WHAT ARE COOKIES?

The Company's Platform uses small files known as cookies to enhance its functionality and improve the User's experience. XCOEX uses technology on its Platform to collect information that helps to enhance User experience and services delivered by XCOEX. The cookies that we use at XCOEX allow the Platform to work and help to understand what information and advertising is most useful to our visitors and Users. This document is intended to explain the cookie practices, their purposes and how they are used.

### Cookie collection

Any personal data provided to or collected by XCOEX via cookies or other tracking technologies is controlled by the Company - XCOEX Limited. By using our Platform, you give consent to our use of cookies in accordance with this Cookie and Privacy Policies.

## USE OF COOKIES

The Company uses cookies to make XCOEX Platforms easier to use, to deliver a personalised experience, and to better tailor our products, services and the Platform to your interests and needs. XCOEX uses both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. A session ID cookie does not expire when the User closes the browser. A persistent cookie is stored in the User's browser storage for an extended period of time. A User can remove persistent cookies by following directions provided in the User's Internet browser's "help" file.

The Company sets persistent cookies for statistical purposes. Persistent cookies also enable the Company to track the location and interests of the Users and to enhance the experience of Company's services on the Platform.

### Controlling and deleting cookies

There are several ways of controlling and deleting cookies:

- You can refuse to give consent for use and storage of cookies. (If a User rejects cookies, the User may still use the Platform);
- You can disable XCOEX or third-party cookies by using your browser settings.

(Most Internet browsers are initially set up to automatically accept cookies. If you do not want our websites to store cookies on your device, you can change your browser settings so that you receive a warning before certain cookies are stored. You can also adjust your settings so that your browser refuses most of our cookies or only certain cookies from third parties. You can also withdraw your consent to cookies by deleting the cookies that have already been stored. If you disable the cookies that we use, this may impact your experience while on the our website, for example you may not be able to visit certain areas of the website or you may not receive personalised information when you visit a website. The procedures for changing your settings and cookies vary from browser to browser. If necessary, use the help function on your browser).
