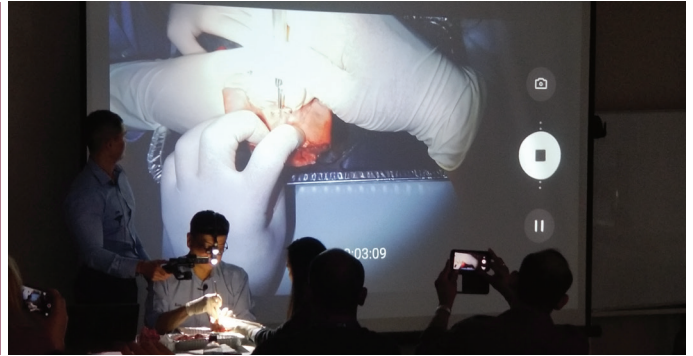

The final osteotomy should be 2mm away from the labial or buccal plate.
That will allow sufficient nutrition to that area and prevent resorption of the bone.
