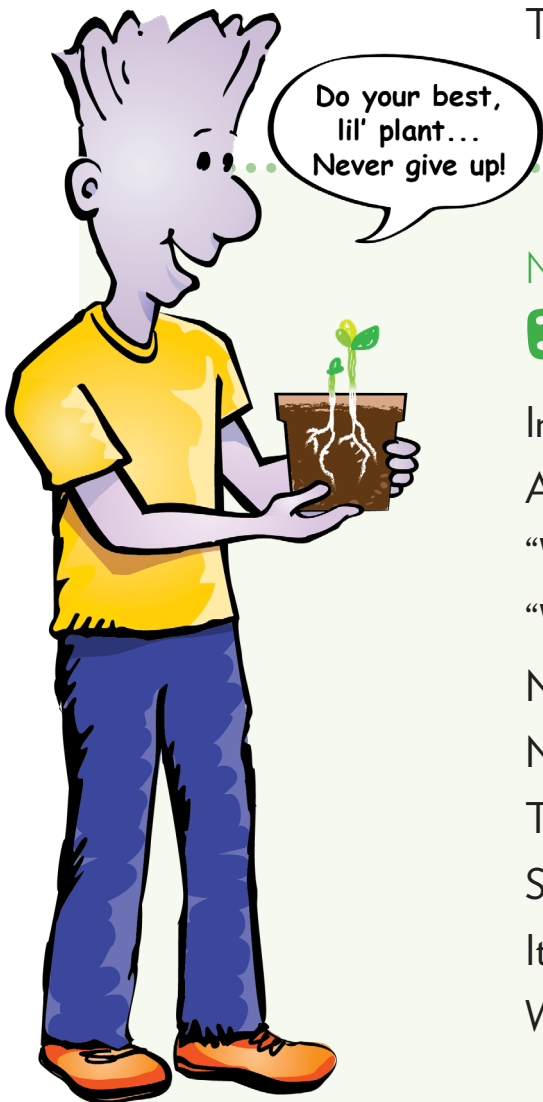


NED'S PLANT POEM
