



## Fuel Surcharge Report June 2021

The average UK pump price for diesel was 131.0 pence per litre during May 2021.

In accordance with our fuel surcharge policy, our fuel surcharge will therefore be increased to 14.0% with effect from Monday, 7 June 2021.

Fuel surcharges have been necessary to cope with fluctuations in the price of diesel and whilst we appreciate that such charges are never welcome, we do try to ensure that our charges are competitive and transparent. We use reliable and trusted sources such as the AA and the Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy to establish average UK pump prices.
