Jennifer Venable Austin, a Knoxville native, was an original member of the East Tennessee Children's Dance Ensemble. Following high school, she majored in dance at the University of Tennessee, performing as a soloist for UT's New Repertory Dance Company. She continued her dance training in New York City: modern dance training with the Martha Graham Company, Alvin Aliey, and Limon School, while her ballet training was with the Joffrey Ballet. Jennifer's extensive jazz training includes Bob Fosse, Louigi, Frank Hatchett, and Joe Tremaine.

After several professional dance years, Jennifer founded Arts In Motion in Kingston, TN. Currently, Arts in Motion provides fine arts dance training for over 400 East Tennessee students. They currently stage the largest production of The Nutcracker in Tennessee (over 100 cast members) and are known for their Summer SOLO (Summer of Learning Opportunity) intensive dance camp - teaching modern, jazz and ballet as well as dance history, and video analysis. Jennifer has also been a choreographer for the College and Community Musical Productions (The Rocky Horror Picture Show, Oklahoma, Sound of Music, Pipin, Seussical, Oliver, Hello Dolly, You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown, and Meet Me in St. Louis). She continues her dance education with bi-yearly trips to New York City, training at Broadway Dance Center and The Ailey Institution, and teaches over 20 classes a week in styles such as ballet, jazz, modern (Graham and Limon style), hip-hop, musical theatre, pilates, and yoga.

### **Summer Tuition Policy**

- Registration is open through the first day of classes, June 24, 2019. Space is limited and is on a first comefirst served basis.
- Tuition must be paid in full with your registration and is non-refundable.

### **Academy Protocol**

- Denton Ballet Academy reserves the right to deny attendance and/or withdraw your student from class if at any time behavior becomes a distraction to the other students or teachers.
- Students should arrive a minimum of 5 minutes prior to the start of their class. Students should be properly dressed and waiting quietly until their teacher invites them into the classroom. If a student arrives late, they are to wait at the door where the teacher can see them until invited in to the classroom.
- Under no circumstances should students hang/lean on the bars, or run in the ballet studio.
- Students may not leave the classroom without asking the teacher's permission; upon return, students must wait outside the studio door for the teacher to invite them back into the class at an appropriate time.
- ♦ Bottled water is allowed in the studio. Food and drinks, especially those in paper cups, are not allowed in the studio or any of the common areas. If a snack needs to be consumed, please do so outside.
- During class, students should raise their hand to speak and avoid talking with other students.
- It is customary for students to curtsy and thank their teacher at the end of each class.
- Parents, please feel free to watch your student if you would like. However we ask that you are discreet so as to not distract them from their learning.
- Absolutely no photos or videos may be taken of students while they are in the studio.

#### **Dress Code**

- Girls Level I & II: Pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers, black tap shoes, hair pulled back and secured.
  - Girls Level III: Lavender leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers, black tap & jazz shoes, hair pulled back and secured.
  - <u>Girls Intermediate Level, Girls Advanced</u>: Black leotard, pink convertible tights, pink canvas ballet slippers. Hair must be groomed neatly into a classic ballet bun with no loose hair or bangs.
- Boys: White T-shirt, black tights, black canvas slippers.
- Students are required to wear a cover-up and street shoes when coming to, and leaving from the Academy. It is inappropriate to wear dance clothes/shoes or costumes as street clothes. This applies to students of all ages.
