Kempinski, Dominica

Expect this to be the Caribbean island on everyone’s radar next year. In part, because its jungle covered mountains and winding rivers mean this speck in the West Indies has exactly the type of wild terrain adventure wellness travelers are looking for. But it will also be because there’s finally a high-end hotel to appeal to those who may want to do the jungle hike, but then return to high thread counts, room service and acres of pools to relax next to. The **Kempinski** opens next month, facing the cerulean waters of Douglas Bay and backed by the pines and flora of the island’s Cabrit’s National Park, filled with waterfalls, canyons, and natural hot springs. The spacious suites have views of the mountains, while restaurants serve local Creole-inflected dishes and freshly-caught fish, and the breezy bar pours from a healthy selection of island rums.



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
