- Purchase, maintain, and track SUE and survey equipment and supplies.
- Manage and maintain fleet.
- Develop, oversee, and train SUE field processes.
- Develop relationships with subconsultants (pothole vendors, GPR, traffic control, camera investigations). Schedule and oversee subcontracts to support project managers.
- Develop relationships with local agencies to better understand specific permit and field requirements. Maintain and submit required permits.
- Schedule field investigations with staff resources and clients.
- Develop data tables, reports, and presentation materials.
- Execute quality control procedures in accordance with company standards.
- Adhere to company safety policies.
- Lead SUE cross training for utility engineering staff
- Champion company-wide process for innovation, education, and consistent implementation.
