safety of canal walls following the collapse of three on the northern Gold Coast during wet weather.

"We're expecting another wet season, I think it's timely we address this issue urgently," he told the Sun.

"Since the March 2010 report, three walls collapsed during wet weather in January this year."

Cr Pforr said their collapse raised serious questions about their original design and construction of these walls.

"We also need to investigate whether

worry in summer residents are pre-loading their walls in set-back areas and if they are having them inspected and maintained," he said.

Cr Pforr has called on city solicitor David Montgomery to present a report on revetment walls to the Gold Coast City Council before summer rains start.

"I am concerned about the design and blockages of weep holes in these walls, which can cause blistering in front of the council's rock armour.

Cr Pforr has campaigned for many years for canal walls to be maintained by homeowners to prevent widespread collapse during heavy rains.
