TRUE+WAY ASL (TWA) is a technology-driven curriculum that provides online videos and interactive activities. TWA’s main objective is to promote real-world conversations related to student’s daily lives with the goal of students being able to converse with Deaf people in the community.

The access code to TWA included in our registration price gives students access to the units used in their class level for 6 months.
