FAR NIENTE: ONE OF THE NAPA VALLEY'S ORIGINAL 19th CENTURY STONE WINERIES

Producer of possibly the oldest bottle of California wine

Oakville, CA – Far Niente, renowned for its production of estate bottled Napa Valley Chardonnay and Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon, was one of Napa Valley's original stone wineries at the time of its construction in the late 19th century. The winery stands today as a stunning example of the region's early winemaking heritage.

Far Niente was founded in 1885 by John Benson, an original forty-niner of the California gold rush and uncle of the artist Winslow Homer. Benson hired architect Hamden McIntyre, creator of the former Christian Brothers winery (now the Culinary Institute of America) and the Gustav Niebaum winery (today's Inglenook winery), to design the building. Constructed against a hillside in western Oakville, Far Niente functioned as a gravity flow winery, gently moving the grapes through each stage of production. Benson named the winery "Far Niente," taken from the Italian phrase "Dolce Far Niente," meaning, "sweet to do nothing."

Nineteen eighty-two marked the return of winemaking to Far Niente, with the harvest of the winery's first Cabernet Sauvignon. Chardonnay was also produced at the winery for the first time that year. Although Nickel made Far Niente Chardonnay in 1979, 1980 and 1981, the wines were made at a warehouse in Sausalito. Today, the winery continues to focus on producing only the two varietal wines.
