WHAT FUNDING IS AVAILABLE?

Congress has authorized over \$190 billion in available funds through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund. The funds were authorized as a part of three federal stimulus packages whose overall purpose is to bolster the economy and supporting schools and districts in addressing the impact of COVID-19.

HOW CAN I USE STIMULUS FUNDS?

Districts can use funds for allowable uses, such as addressing learning loss among students disproportionately affected by the coronavirus and school closures and preparing schools for reopening. Any district spending that is traditionally authorized by the ESEA of 1965, McKinney-Vento, IDEA, AEFLC, or Perkins laws is allowable under ESSER II and ESSER III.
