

Environmental Policy

GSE Plant Limited is committed to conducting our operations in an environmentally responsible manner. We consider compliance with statutory requirements to be a minimum level of performance, which will be improved by fulfilling the requirements below.

In our own rental and transport fleet we seek to:

- Maintain equipment to maximise effectiveness and minimise fuel consumption.
- Progressively improve fuel efficiency when we update our rental and transport fleets.
- Maintain equipment in designated locations to avoid environmental incidents and pollution; and
- Maximise re-use and recycling opportunities when equipment is disposed of.

In our rental and transport operations, we seek to:

- Operate equipment in the most effective way practical.
- Cause no significant adverse environmental incidents or pollution.
- Consult those affected by our work; and
- Conduct our activities in a considerate manner.

In maintenance and other operations on our own premises and on site we seek to:

- Minimise consumption and waste on all fuels.
- Reduce noise, dust and other emissions.
- Dispose of used waste oil and other materials in a responsible way through approved contractors; and
- Use best practise to minimise spillage and effluent, and to avoid pollution of waterways.

We will achieve this by:

- Working collaboratively with equipment manufacturers, our customers, their clients, and local communities.
- Advising our customers on the arrangement of operations to minimise fuel usage and environmental impact.
- Identifying significant risks to the environment from our operations and taking practical steps to managing these risks.
- Ensuring through training that our staff are aware of the potential environmental impacts of their actions.
- Ensuring through training that our employees know how to operate equipment to minimise environmental impact; and
- Seeking innovation and continuous improvement in the way we work to achieve better environmental outcomes.

The Director of GSE Plant Ltd is responsible for establishing this Environmental Policy for the Group, and for reviewing the performance of the Company.

It is the responsibility of every manager and employee in this business to:

- Perform his or her job whilst conforming with all statutory environmental requirements.
- Stop and advise a customer's representative if they believe their actions could be or are causing environmental incident(s).
- Look out for opportunities that could improve the company's environmental performance.

This policy will be reviewed regularly, and is to be read, understood and implemented in conjunction with the Company's Safety Policy.
