



Overview:

Caroil IADC DIT Working At Heights is designed to support all personnel assigned to working at height with the awareness of the hazards involved in the operations and how to safely plan and execute the task.

Delegates will have the opportunity to build the knowledge and experience of how to properly inspect and use the safety gear and how to safely perform the operations whilst working at height.

Requirements:

There are no mandatory pre-requisites to attend Caroil IADC DIT Working At Heights course.

The course is designed for Drillers, Assistant Drillers, Derrickhands, Floorhands, Mechanics, Electricians and any other person whose duties requires to perform Work At Height operations.



Course Delivery:

The course includes both theoretical and practical sessions, covering the following topics:

- Understand working at heights definition and its associated risks
- Describe the risk control hierarchy principles applicable to working at heights
- Be familiar with drilling industry administrative safety tools
- Know the approved fall protection equipment, selection and proper utilization
- Demonstrate how to correctly inspect and care for fall protection equipment
- Explain how to control tools aloft
- Describe the rescue plan and its importance

Certification:

- Written and practical tests will be performed
- Caroil Instructor will perform a competency assessment during the practical part of the training
- Successful completion of the course and a pass mark of 80% or above will result in a Caroil & IADC issued Certificate valid for two (2) years.
