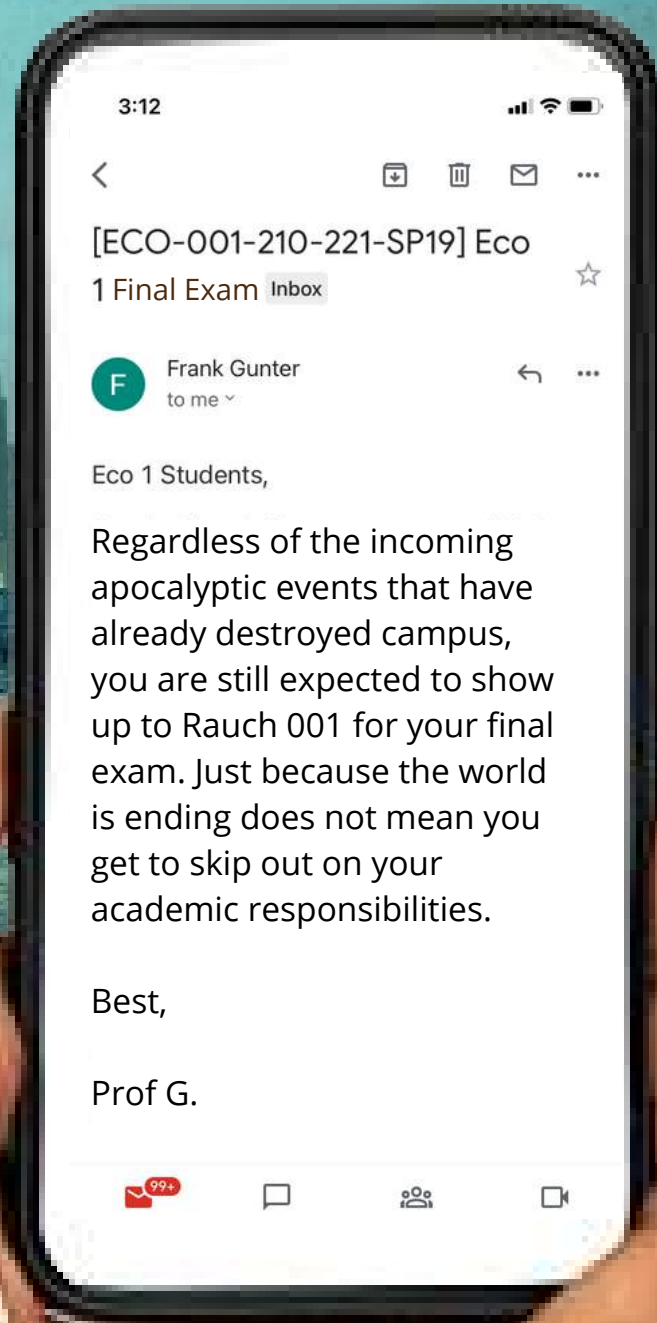

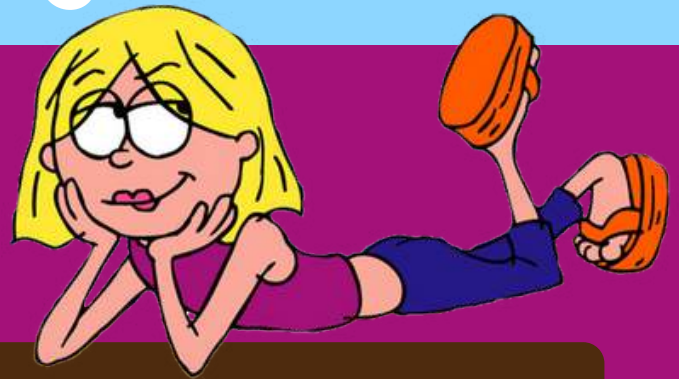

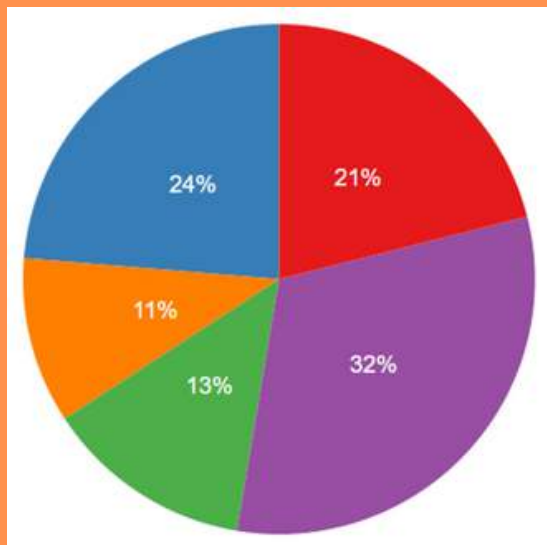
Eat more beef. Cows produce a lot of methane, so punish them by chomping down on a hamburger at least once a day.

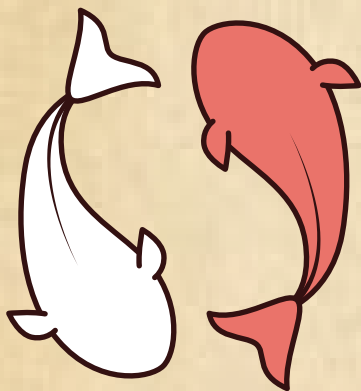
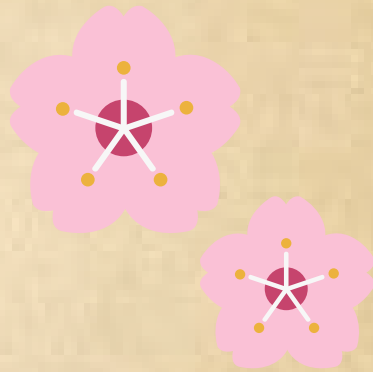

1. Randomly scream "emissions" and "sustainability" in group settings.

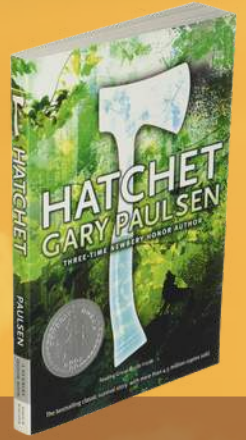
2. Put a paper straw in your coffee, but keep plastic straws in your bag. Only switch it out when no one's looking.

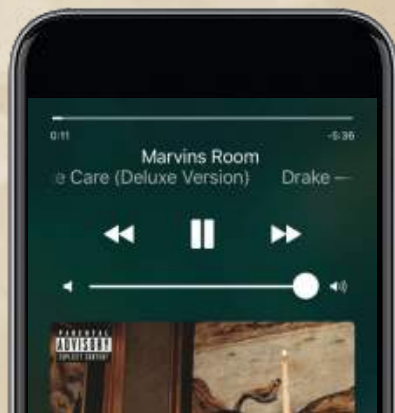

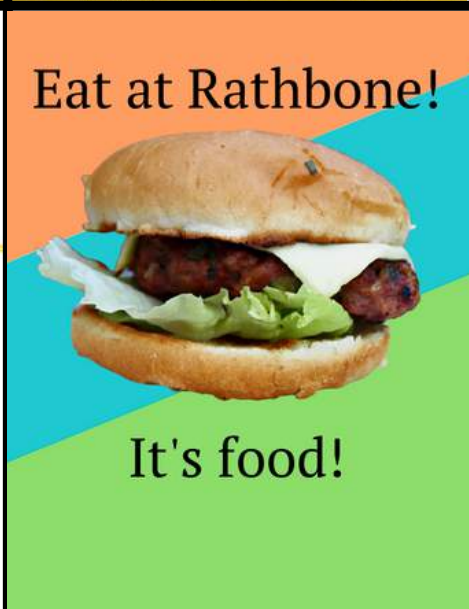
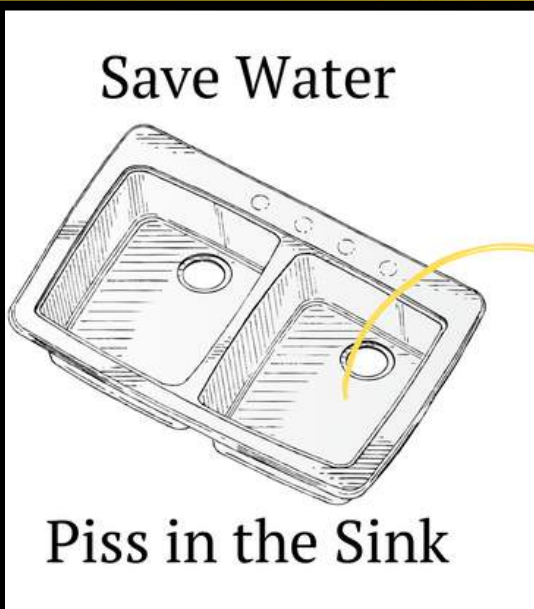
Dear Editor,
