## COVID-19

### Director of Ohio Department of Health's "Stay At Home" Order Business Reminder Checklist

- The facility must maintain a distance of six (6) feet between employees and customers with signage, tape, or by other means.
- The facility must provide employees access to opportunities to wash their hands with soap and water or the use of hand sanitizer.
- Hand sanitizer available for employees and customers.
- Implement separate operating hours for elderly and vulnerable customers.
- Clean high touch surfaces regularly (ex. workstations, countertops, door handles). Provide disposable wipes so these common surfaces can be wiped down by employees.
- Employees with acute respiratory illness symptoms are separated and immediately sent home.

#### **Stores that sell groceries and medicine effective Tuesday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020:**

- Determine the maximum capacity of persons permitted in your store at any one time to ensure that all persons can safely and comfortably maintain a 6-foot distance from each other.
- Display the maximum capacity on the front entrance.
- If a line is present inside or outside, make sure a 6-foot distance is maintained between people who are not in the same household.
- Properly clean baskets and shopping carts between all customers.
