



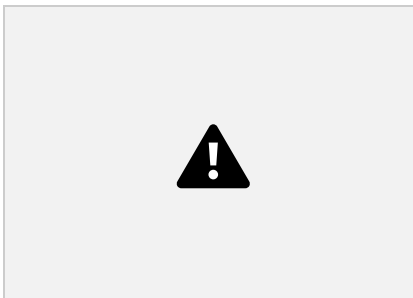
Camp Chef

Camp ELSO is a Portland based non-profit organization providing outdoor STEAM based science summer day camps with hands-on experiential learning programs for Black and Brown youth to **Experience Life Science Outdoors**. Our mission is to empower youth of color to explore the possibilities of careers in science fields, by exposing them to unique outdoor learning opportunities, while nurturing a love for the outdoors. We strive to accomplish this mission through implementing a summer program experience in a day camp format, which includes daily field trips for youth in K-8th grade. The Wayfinders program provides culturally relevant environmental and STEAM education. This program intertwines four main areas: life science, ecology, community, and cultural history.

Description: The role of a Camp Chef is to create healthy, delicious and quick snacks/lunch for the Wayfinders Camp Participants and Camp Guides. In addition to creating camp participants snacks/lunches, the Camp Chef is also responsible for doing weekly shopping and making sure any of the camp participants with dietary restrictions (allergies/GF/vegan) are kept and maintained.

Essential Job Functions

- Passion and interest in supporting science and environmental learning opportunities for underrepresented youth
- Complete weekly shopping for the Wayfinders Summer Program. Shop for lunch/snack items
- Create youth lunches and snacks on a daily basis
- Culturally competent- experience working with children of color from diverse backgrounds
- Ensure health and safety of the kitchen location you are working at/from
- Communicate professionally and in a timely manner to the Wayfinders Program Director
- Close attention to details which include time management (staying on schedule)



- Report all accidents, problems, and successes to W. Program Director (maintain and complete a daily log)
- Experience or interest in creating lunches/snacks for elementary and middle

school age children

Skills and Qualifications

- Must have clean background check
- Volunteer and/or work experience with cooking/creating meals for up to 40 youth
