



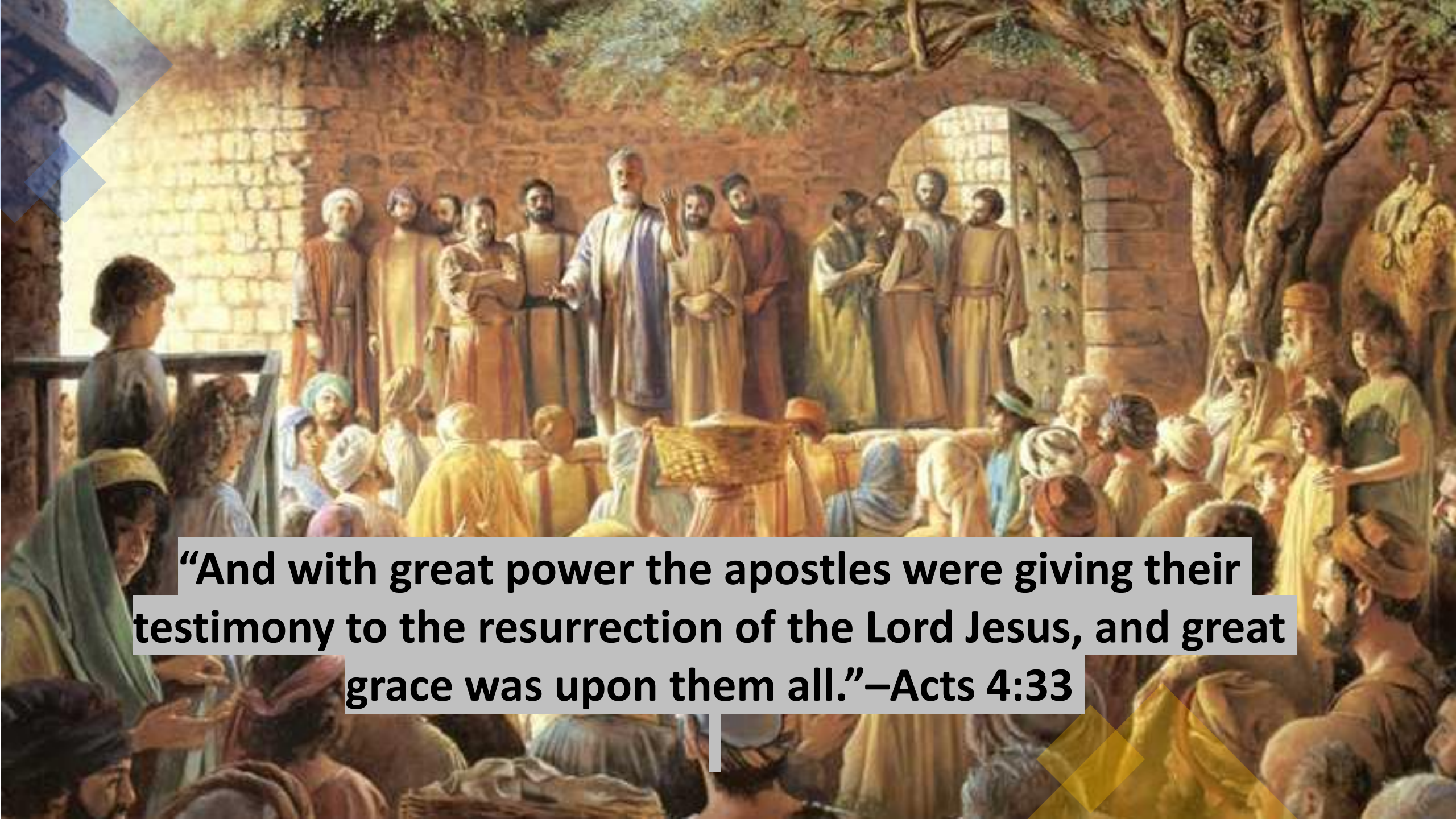
Being Spirit Filled




Peter and John before the Pharisees. – Acts 4:1-4


