Apply for one of eight full-tuition ministry leadership scholarships to Knox Theological Seminary to further the gospel in South Florida!

Since our founding in 1989, South Florida has been home to Knox Theological Seminary. Today, we celebrate what the Lord has done through hundreds of alumni who serve and minister locally while looking ahead to meeting the growing spiritual needs of this vibrant and culturally diverse community we are proud to call home.

Thanks to a generous grant from the Celia Lipton and Victor W. Farris Foundation as well as supporters of Knox Seminary, we are delighted to advance our continued commitment to South Florida by offering a total of eight full-tuition scholarships over the next two years to residents of South Florida who are actively engaged in gospel ministry!

The mission of Knox Theological Seminary is unwavering. *We are a seminary in the tradition of the Reformation that exists to educate men and women to declare and demonstrate the Gospel of Jesus Christ.* We believe our calling is to equip upcoming Christian leaders in the contexts where God has called them in collaboration with their local church or ministry leadership. Through our dedicated and reliable online platform, in-person residential course offerings, and uncompromising academic excellence, Knox continues to attract students looking for a high-quality seminary education both locally and globally. As a result, Knox alumni are now represented in 23 countries on 6 continents serving in pastoral ministry or other gospel-focused contexts.

Now, as part of Knox's strategic plan, we are investing even more into the formation of pastoral and ministry leaders to serve our local South Florida community's spiritual needs by declaring and demonstrating the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Over each of the next two years, Knox will award four [Master of Divinity](#) and four [Master of Arts \(Biblical and Theological Studies\)](#) degree program scholarships to active, local church and ministry leaders with financial need – a total value over \$300,000 – to engage South Florida!

Application Requirements

Qualifications

Scholarship recipients must:

- Be a new student applicant not already enrolled in a program at Knox.
- Meet degree program eligibility requirements for acceptance into the program beginning the 2021-22 or 2022-23 academic year.
- Reside in and actively serving in a full-time¹ ministry or Christian educational context in South Florida (Miami-Dade, Broward, or Palm Beach county).
- Demonstrate financial need (see below for more information).

Terms & Conditions

- Recipients must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Any tuition for a failed or incomplete/withdrawn course must be paid by the student.
- Recipients are responsible for on-time payment of all student fees.
- Engage S. Florida Scholarships may not be combined with any other scholarship or reduction in tuition.
- Online and residential courses are covered in the scholarship.
- **Recipients receiving the scholarship must attend at least four residential course offerings per year.**

Interested applicants should:

1. Complete and submit the regular new student Knox application at knoxseminary.edu and pay the required application fee.
2. Complete and submit the Engage South Florida Scholarship Application & Student Financial Statement that demonstrates financial need and eligibility.
3. Submit with the application a 500-word essay that includes a detailed description of the student's current ministry context and work along with how the applicant anticipates their chosen degree program will further benefit their ministry.
4. Submit with the application a letter of support from their direct supervisor or other, relevant leader from their current ministry, indicating the student will be allowed the necessary work flexibility to allow for successful pursuit of an academic degree according to the terms above.
