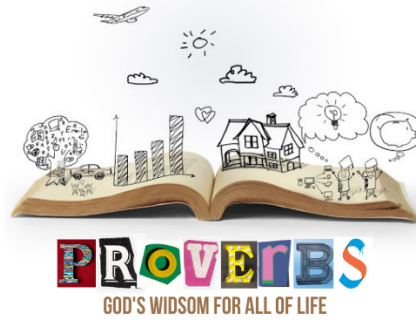

## RBT Discussion Study Guide

→ Take a moment to pray and ask God to help you understand and apply what you read.

Ask: "**What?**"

Go back through your reading and ask questions like: What did it say? What insights do I gain? What did I learn about God? About myself? About life?

Then ask: "**So What?**"

Imagine someone read that same passage and asked you, "What does this have to do with life today?" What's the answer? What lesson or teaching does God communicate through this passage?

Finally, ask "**Now What?**"

Ask God what He wants you to do with what you read. In what way do you need to believe, live, respond, etc. differently based on what you read? This goes beyond a general or universal lesson to specific application for your life. Ask God for the wisdom and strength to live out what He's shown you.
