Data Profiling

What is Data profiling?

Broadly speaking, data profiling refers to the process by which an Organization gains an understanding of the characteristics of its data. For example, understanding how much data exists, whether or not the data is clean, how often the data is used and for what purpose.



Why Data profiling?

Data profiling examines the data in an application. The result of a data profiling can enable an organization make better decisions on how to manage the data that exists.

Profiling can also unearth data relationships & lineage information that previously may not have been considered relevant.

In essence, profiling is the first step in the journey towards transforming raw data into information, and then intelligence.



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
