

REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING SEPTEMBER 16, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Matt Lehto. There were 8 towns people present. The minutes of August Monthly Board Meeting and the Special Board Meetings were read. A motion was made by Matt G and second by Ryan VO to accept all of the meeting minutes as presented. The Treasurer presented the Treasurer's Report. A total of \$9,762.36 was submitted to pay bills. We had a credit balance of \$106,124.34 in the checking account. A motion was made by Matt G second by Matt L to accept the Treasurer's Report.

*Fire Department Report: None.

*Sheriffs Report: Ashland County Sheriff Jason Janecek was present. Stated that vandalism of shooting animals has been happening in a lot of towns right now.

*Old Business: None

*New Business: The Clerk brought to the Board a possible opportunity for the Town to receive funds through a Local (WI DOT Multimodal Supplement Program) Program to help with the roads if we qualify. The Board will look this over.

The Salt/Sand Contract was discussed. This is through Ashland County. The amount we need for this winter needs to be to them by October 15th. They will not have this on an on-call basis. The Chairman will talk to the roadmen to see how much was purchased last year and how much they think we need this year.

Discussion on the Weight Limit Signs. Many of them are not legal as they have duct tape on them and different weight limits for the same roads. The Board will talk to the Roadmen and see what signs we have that are still good and how many that will need replaced and order them accordingly. There is still over \$4,000 in the budget for signs.

Clerk stated the Town had received a check from FEMA for the July 2018 Park Road Project for \$12,265.96.

Public Input: Question about if Town of Marengo also pays 1/3 of the Fire Dept's Increase. Yes they do. Resident happy about the mowing on Schwiesow Road. Resident happy with the roads. They are in very nice shape. There have been some complaints about excessive speed on Jolma Rd.

A motion was made by Ryan VO and second by Matt G to adjourn.
