ATV (ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE) ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE # 20-001

**STATE OF WISCONSIN }
Town of White River }
Ashland County }**

The Town Board of the Town of White River, Ashland County, Wisconsin, has specific authority under s. 23.33 Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 23.33 Wis. Stats., there are hereby designated All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) Routes in the Town of White River, Ashland County. All Town of White River Roads are ATV routes.

All Terrain Vehicle operation on said routes shall be subject to the following limitations:

- A. ATV's should be operated at a prudent speed at all times
- B. ATV's should be operated in single-file on the right side of the road
- C. ATV Operators shall come to a complete stop crossing or entering any other road junction and shall yield the right of way to all vehicles or pedestrians approaching such intersections
- D. Left turns shall be made as safely as possible from any position depending on road conditions and visibility
- E. ATV operators shall yield right of way to other vehicular traffic and pedestrians
- F. ATV's shall be operated with a lighted headlamp and taillamp at all times
- G. ATV operation is not permitted on any highway or roadway other than designated with signs
- H. Any person operating an ATV shall obey all of the rules of the road applicable to operating a motor vehicle contained in Chapter 346 WI Stats.
- I. All persons operating on the designated ATV Routes shall travel at their own risk and the Town of White River shall not be responsible to said users for any damage or injuries suffered to persons or property as a result of operating on said routes
- J. In addition to other penalties provided in this chapter, and person(s) who violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit the privilege of using and ATV on the Town of White River routes
- K. This Ordinance shall be self-renewing unless revoked by the Town of White River

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80 Wis. Stats.
