

REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING FEBRUARY 15, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Matt Lehto. There were 5 towns people and 1 Sheriff present. The minutes of January Monthly Board Meeting were read. A motion was made by Matt G and second by Ryan VO to accept the meeting minutes as read. The Treasurer presented the Treasurer's Report. A total of \$2,922.45 was submitted to pay bills. We had a credit balance of \$140,525.80 in the checking account. A motion was made by Matt L second by Matt G to accept the Treasurer's Report.

*Sheriff's Department Report:

Sheriff's Dept getting closer to full staff. New Chief Deputy took over last week.

*Old Business:

Vacant Clerk Position- There has been no interest. Clerk had put an Ad in the local newspaper a couple of times but no one sent a resume or showed any interest in the position. Chairman and others will continue to ask around for any available candidates.

Snowmobile Ordinance- Clerk typed up a Snowmobile Ordinance for the Board to review and make any corrections. The Board accepted it as is and a motion was made by Matt L and a 2nd by Ryan VO to Adopt the Town of White River Snowmobile Ordinance. Ordinance was signed by Board Members and attested by the Clerk. Clerk will post this ordinance as required under s.60.80 Wis. Stats. And email a copy to the Local Law Enforcement and WI DNR.

*New Business:

Treasurer asked for a motion to approve the payments of the tax overpayments and dog licenses. A motion was made by Matt L and a 2nd by Matt G to do this.

Snow Wing Cart- Discussion about purchasing a Snow Wing Cart for the Town. This is needed for storing and removing the wing from the grader and truck. Approximate cost is about \$3000. There was a motion made by Matt G and a 2nd by Ryan VO to purchase this.

Driveway/Culvert Permit- C Anderson on Redinger Rd submitted a permit but not payment. The Board signed the permit and it can be issued when we do receive the fee of \$25.

Public Input: None

Resident on Adler asked the Board for a bigger STOP sign by his driveway for snowmobiles. The Board instructed him to contact maybe the Ashland County Snowmobile Alliance as the trails are not "owned" by the town.

Resident on Adler road wanted to petition for guard rails on the sharp corner of Adler Rd. Board will discuss this as the next meeting when it is on the agenda however that road is set for

reconstruction this summer.

Resident expressed they are happy with the board meeting time change and the sand that has been spread on the roads.

A motion was made by Ryan VO and second by Matt L to adjourn.
The meeting was adjourned at 6:34 p.m.
