

REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING APRIL 20, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm by Chairman Matt Lehto immediately following the Annual Meeting. There were 4 towns people and present. The minutes of March Monthly Board Meeting were read. A motion was made by Ryan VO and second by Matt G to accept the meeting minutes as read. The Treasurer presented the Treasurer's Report. A total of \$23,790.37 was submitted to pay bills. We had a credit balance of \$117,653.32 in the checking account. A motion was made by Matt L second by Matt G to accept the Treasurer's Report.

Town Clerk Position Vacant. The Town Board appointed Shelley Jolma as the Town Clerk to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term, ending on April 18, 2023. Shelley Jolma signed the Official Oath and accepted the position.

Part Time Town Employee- The Town Hired Shelley Jolma as a Part time employee for her "non Clerk duties" per WI Stats 60.37 (4) subsection B and Town of White River Resolution 2020-1. A motion was made by Matt L and a 2nd by Matt G. All board members in favor.

Treasurer asked for approval to transfer \$15,200 to the checking account for the 1st half of the Fire Department Protection Services. A Motion was made by Ryan VO and a second by Matt G to transfer this.

Road Bans Removal- Discussion about when this should be done. The Board decided to follow Ashland County and remove the Road bans on April 26, 2021 with the exception of Redinger Rd unless the Roadman sees otherwise.

Roads with too High Shoulders- Roads will not drain properly if the shoulders are too high. Should the Roadmen possibly dig those out onto the road and then use loader to scoop off of the road? Chairman will discuss this with the Roadman and come up with the best solution.

Redinger Rd Potholes- There are potholes in the new double chip seal. These are not under warranty as it was only as good as the base was. The construction company that laid it said they could possibly come back and re do those spots if the Town would dig them out and fix them.

Public Input:

Jim O asked if the board could make sure his lawn mower was all tuned and ready for the summer. Resident asked why the board decided to do double chip seal.

A motion was made by Ryan VO and second by Matt G to adjourn.
The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
