APPOINTED CLERK AND TREASURER ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE # 21-002

**STATE OF WISCONSIN }
Town of White River }
Ashland County }**

The Town Board of the Town of White River, Ashland County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:
That, pursuant to Wis. Stat 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the town clerk and town treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appointed positions shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per Wis. Stat 60.30(1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officers for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" defined under Wis. Stat. 60.30(1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on Tuesday, April 5, 2022. The referendum question shall be:

"Shall the persons holding the office of the town clerk and the town treasurer in the Town of White River be appointed by the town board?"

The salary of the appointed positions shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per Wis. Stat. 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by Wis. Stat. 60.30(1e)(b).
