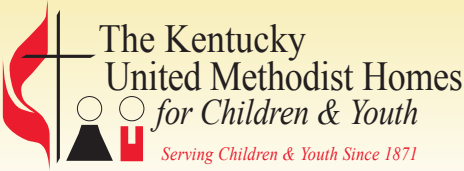

**Residential Treatment**  
Provides residential therapeutic intervention for youth, ages 12-17, who have emotional and behavioral problems due to histories of abuse, neglect, abandonment and trauma.

**Forward Focus (Home Detention)**  
Monitoring of youth court ordered for home detention. Providing accountability and services for at-risk youth so they may remain at home.

**Emergency Shelter**  
Provides temporary housing to youth, ages 12-17, who are referred for short-term care by the Dept. of Community Services or Dept. of Juvenile Justice.

**Next Step (Substance Abuse Program)**  
Serves families in their communities. Therapists and case managers provide therapeutic intervention for those suffering with substance abuse and link youth to community supports.

Assisted 40 families through the adoption process. The licensed, private program offers domestic and international adoptions and is located in Owensboro.

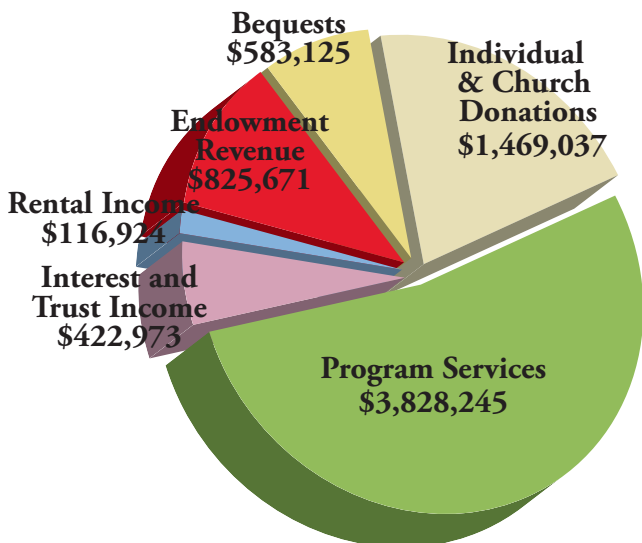
