The Bachelor in International Relations and Diplomacy offers students an international curriculum that encompasses scientific technological, cultural and humanitarian concerns, as well as the more traditional areas of diplomatic activities. In their final two years of study, students will go on to apply their analytical skills to case studies, debates, and on-site visits.
