Sapienship is inviting applications for the position of Educational Project Leader & Content Developer, either as a full-time or part-time appointment. This is a new role that will focus on driving forward the company's partnerships with educational bodies, as well as creating engaging, accessible and thought-provoking educational content. This content will include lesson plans and workshops for adults and students (at both middle and high school levels). For example, short introductions to academic disciplines from a fresh macro-perspective, activities that explore contemporary challenges (like employability and privacy), etc.

Core Responsibilities

- Building a strategic plan with global reach for the educational department.
- Liaising with potential partners on developing and distributing workshops.
- Developing educational materials from inception to completion.
- Creating promotional materials to market educational initiatives globally.
- Collaborating closely with the wider Sapienship team to align project development with the company's full portfolio of initiatives.

Basic Requirements

- Experience of +3 years in developing engaging educational material – or comparable content in another field – that was successfully implemented.
- M.Phil, M.A or Ph.D. degree (or equivalent) in the humanities or sciences.
- Evidence of academic excellence.
- Experience of 2-3 years in leading and managing projects.
- Excellent written and spoken English, at native level.
- Experience of creating design briefs, storyboards, scripts, and knowledge quizzes.
- Good proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite, Adobe Acrobat Pro and Google Drive.
- Familiarity with the fields of instructional design, instructional technology, and information technology is an advantage.
- Experience with multimedia authoring tools (such as Adobe Creative Suite, Articulate 360, Camtasia Studio) is an advantage.



- Experience of integrating gamification elements into self-paced learning experiences, as well as graphic design and animation skills, is also an advantage.

Additional Requirements

- Passion for promoting critical thinking, science, history, and other disciplines.
- Proven ability to present information in a creative, fun and clear way.
- Attention to detail and quality in content creation, and an understanding of the importance of scientific rigour.
- Ability to work productively under pressure and to deadlines.
- Ability to work well both independently and as part of teams / partnerships.
- Ability to interact at the most professional level with high-profile global organizations
- Consistent use of discretion, judgment, and initiative.

Additional Information

- This is a permanent position that is offered as either a part-time appointment (with 2 to 3 regular working-days per week) or a full-time appointment (depending on the candidate's availability).
- A successful candidate who does not reside in Israel, will work from home.
- A successful candidate who resides in Israel can either work from home or at the company's offices in Tel Aviv.
